2. The Petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with C.T. Case No.4331 of 2022 pending on the file of learned J.M.F.C., (Cog Taking)-2, Bhubaneswar, arising out of Mancheswar P.S. Case No.253 of 2025 for commission of offences punishable under Sections 294, 323, 34, 420 and 506 of IPC.
3. Issue notice to the Opposite Party No.2 by Speed Post with A.D. Requisites shall be filed by 26.08.2025.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner is also requested to serve an extra copy of the brief on the learned counsel for the State, who is requested to



serve the notice on the informant through the I.O. indicating that the matter shall be taken up on 22.10.2025.

5. List this matter on 22.10.2025. Learned counsel for the State is requested to obtain the Case Diary.

6. As an interim measure, it is directed that the Petitioner shall not be taken into custody in the aforesaid case, till the next date.

In the event of non-filing of the requisites by the date fixed, interim order shall stand vacated.
