9. Learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.S.C. are present.

Perused the execution petition case record and the order dated 02.11.2023 passed by the Hon'ble Court in W.P.(C) No.35112 of 2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that despite several opportunities granted by this Court, no show cause affidavit has been filed by the opposite party. On perusal of the case record, it appears that notwithstanding repeated directions, no compliance report has been filed. Nothing has been brought on record to indicate that the order passed by the Hon'ble Court has been implemented.

In view of the above, it appears that the order passed by the Hon'ble Court requires to be executed through the process of the court. However on going through the execution petition it reveals that the same does not contain all the particulars as required u/o 21 R.11 C.P.C.
