01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.
2. By means of this application, the Petitioner seeks the following relief:

“The petitioner, therefore, humbly prays that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to admit this Writ Petition, issue writ of mandamus or any direction/directions to the Opposite Parties, more particularly the Opposite Party No. 1 to 3/or in the event of death, their successors to comply the direction passed in R.F.A.No.139 of 2007 strictly as per the decree and any other direction(s) be issued to the Opposite Party No. 10 to take care the right to property of the present Petitioners in view of the direction passed in R.F.A.No.139 of 2007.”

3. As seen from the averments made in the application, the Petitioners having been favoured in the compromise reached between the litigants in respect to the



scheduled properties before this Court in S.A. No.142 of 1991, the registered sale deed bearing No.1339 of 2006 dated 20.06.2006 was held to be valid. Be that as it may, according to the Petitioners, the fruit of the compromise has not reached them despite the decree. However, the relief prayed for by the Petitioners herein are matters, which require a deeper examination by adjudication in the Execution proceeding. The Petition, therefore, as laid herein, cannot be entertained and the Petitioners are at liberty to approach the appropriate court for the relief claimed.

4. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
