1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. The appellants-petitioners have filed IA No.1299 of 2023 under Rule-22(2) of the Orissa Motor Vehicles (Accident Claims Tribunal) Rules, 1960 (in short, "the Rules") r/w Rule-39(II) of the Rules, 2019 for exemption from paying of Court fees for time being.
3. Heard, Mr. Pradeep Kumar Mishra, learned counsel for the appellants and perused the record.
4. For the reasons stated therein in the IA, the prayer for exemption of payment of Court fees for the time being stands allowed, but the appellants, however, shall pay the Court fee after disposal of this appeal. Accordingly, the IA No.1299 of 2023 stands disposed of.
