11. 1. Heard Mr. C.R. Sahu, learned counsel for Appellant – Petitioner and Mr. G. Tripathy, learned AGA for State.
2. In the present application filed under Section 389 of Cr.P.C./ Section 430 of the BNNS, the Petitioner has prayed for his release on bail pending appeal. He has been convicted by learned Sessions Judge, Keonjhar in Sessions Trial No.68 of 2019 for commission of offences under Sections 302 of the Indian Penal Code and sentenced to undergo R.I. for life along with fine.
3. Upon hearing both parties and going through the impugned judgment as well as the records of the trial court, we are not inclined to release the Petitioner on bail at this stage. Accordingly the prayer for bail is rejected.
