- 9.** In view of the pendency of this transfer petition, liberty is granted to the Petitioner to appear before the Court below and move for an adjournment in CMC No.25 of 2022.
- 10.** It is made clear that, if such an application for adjournment is moved, the learned Court below shall do well to adjourn the proceeding to any date, beyond the week commencing from 10th November, 2025.
- 11.** Urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application as per rules.
