1. None appears for the petitioner at the time of call.
2. Vide order dated 28.11.2025, the Deputy Registrar (Judicial) Lawzima has passed the following order:-

*“None appears for the petitioner(s) at the time of call.*

*Defect(s) pointed out by the stamp reporter be removed within two weeks in the registry failing which the matter be placed before the Hon'ble Bench for orders.*

*List this case on 16.12.2025.*

*If the petitioner / learned counsel removes all the defects prior to the date of adjournment, his/her case shall be registered forthwith to list it before the roster bench without waiting for the expiration of adjourned date.”*



The defects pointed out by the S.R. have not yet been cured in compliance with the aforementioned order.

**3.** The Standing Order No.2 of 2025 in Sub-Clause 3(vi) provides as under:-

**“3. Supplementary Procedure:**

xxx    xxx    xxx    xxx    xxx  
xxx    xxx    xxx    xxx    xxx

(vi) Where defects are not rectified within the period granted by the Lawazima Court, the matter shall be placed before the appropriate Bench, for dismissal for non-compliance or for extension of time under the heading ‘for removal of defects’.”

**4.** In view of the aforementioned Standing Order, the present petition is listed before this Court. Since the defects pointed out by the S.R. have not yet been complied/cured, the petition stands dismissed. However, it is kept open for the petitioner to renew the bail plea, if so advised.
