1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. The appellant-petitioner has filed IA No.2206 of 2025 under Rule-22(2) of the Orissa Motor Vehicles (Accident Claims Tribunal) Rules, 1960 (in short, "the Rules") for exemption from paying of Court fees for time being.
3. Heard learned counsel for the appellant and perused the record.
4. After hearing learned counsel for the appellant and on going through the averments of the IA, the prayer of the appellant for exemption of payment of Court fees for the time being stands allowed till disposal of this appeal. It is, however, made clear that the appellant shall be liable to pay the Court fees as exempted by this order at the time of receiving the award.



5. Accordingly, the IA No.2206 of 2025 stands disposed of.
6. The appellant-petitioner has filed IA No.2207 of 2025 U/S.5 of the Limitation Act for condonation of delay of 139 days in preferring the appeal.
7. Heard. Issue notice on the question of limitation and admission against Respondents/Ops through Speed Post with AD by fixing a short returnable date. Requisites for issuance of notice to the Respondents/Ops shall be filed within three working days.
