Notice issued to the opposite party-husband Sanjit Kumar Mohanta has returned unserved with the noting that 'addressee is out of station'

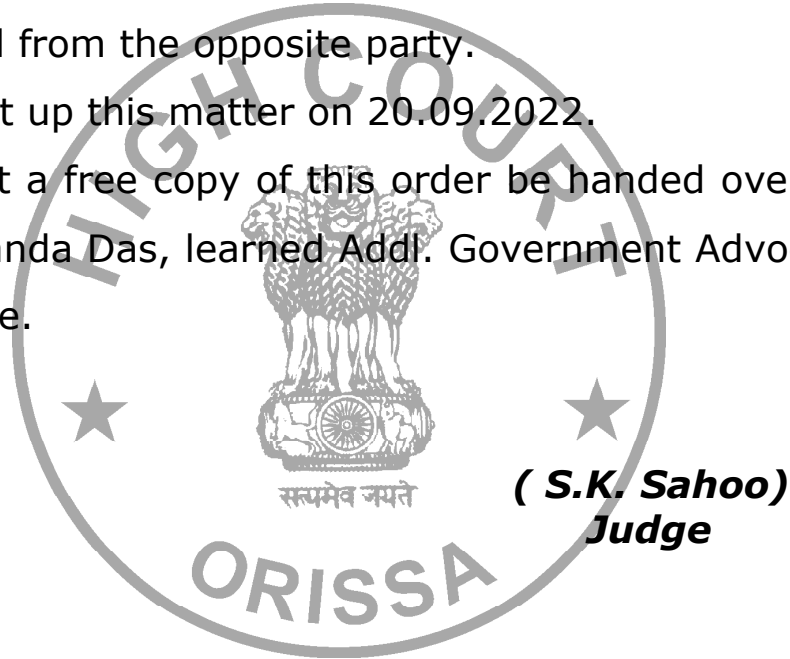
Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the opposite party is very much present in the address given in the cause title which is also similar as per the order passed by the learned J.M.F.C., Karanjia and he is avoiding receipt of notice and he submits that the notice may be directed to be served on the opposite party through the Inspector-in-charge of concerned police station for the ends of justice as the case arises out of 125 of Cr.P.C. proceeding and the petitioner is the wife of the opposite party and she has not received any

maintenance amount till date in spite of the order passed by the learned Magistrate.

In view of such submission, let an extra copy of the revision petition along with impugned order be served on the learned counsel for the State by 08.09.2022, which will be sent to the Inspector in-charge of Jashipur Police Station for its service on the opposite party and it will be intimated to him that the matter will be taken up on 20.09.2022 and if he so likes, he can engage a counsel for him. A written proof regarding service of notice be obtained from the opposite party.

Put up this matter on 20.09.2022.
