1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
 2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner. Perused the application as well as the prayer made therein.
 3. By filing the present application under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., the Petitioners seek to challenge order dated 13.09.2024 passed in 1CC Case No.8062 of 2022 by the learned J.M.F.C., Bhubaneswar, whereby the learned trial Court has granted interim compensation under Section 143-A of the N.I. Act in favour of the complainant.
 4. Learned counsel for the Petitioners at this juncture contended that the impugned order is not in consonance with the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Rakesh Ranjan Shrivastava v. The State of Jharkhand & Another.***
 5. Accordingly, this Court is inclined to issue notice to the Opposite Parties.



6. Since Ms. B.K. Sahu, learned Additional Government Advocate accepts notice on behalf of Opposite Party No.1, extra copy of the application be served on her within a week.
7. Issue notice to the Opposite Party No.2 by Registered Post/Speed Post with A.D. by fixing a short returnable date. Requisites be filed within three working days.
8. List this matter in the week commencing 17.11.2025.
9. As an interim measure, it is directed that the impugned order dated 13.09.2024 under Annexure-1 to the application shall not be given effect to till the next date.
