01. 1. Learned counsel Mr. B. Nayak and associates have entered appearance on behalf of the Informant by filing Vakalatnama. The same is taken on record.
2. Name of learned counsel Mr. Nayak and associates be reflected in the file, cause list as well as in the web portal of this Court.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner, learned counsel for the State and learned counsel for the Informant.
4. The Petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.599 of 2025 pending on the file of learned J.M.F.C., Jatni, arising out of Jatni P.S. Case No.345 of 2025 for commission of



offences punishable under Sections 85/296/115(2)/351(2)/3(5) of BNS read with Section 4 of DP Act.

5. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as informant, on instruction, that their clients are agreeable to explore the possibility of settlement through the ADR by way of Mediation.

6. Accordingly, they are called upon to appear before the learned Mediator on 14.10.2025 at 11.30 A.M. at the High Court of Orissa Mediation Centre, Cuttack to receive further instruction. The Coordinator is requested to do the needful.

7. List this matter on 29.10.2025 along with the report of the learned Mediator.

8. Registry is requested to do the needful.

9. List this matter on the date fixed along with ABLAPL No.10099 of 2025.

10. As an interim measure, it is directed that the Petitioner shall not be taken into custody in connection with the aforesaid case, till the next date.

11. It is needless to say that the Petitioner shall cooperate with the Investigating Agency.
