This application has been filed challenging the order dated 25.08.2025 passed by the learned Special Judge, Vigilance, Keonjhar in Balasore VGR Case No. 13 of 2016 arising out of Balasore Vigilance P.S. Case No. 60 of 2016 (T.R. Case No. 04 of 2023) rejecting the application filed by the Petitioner for her discharge.
2. Mr. B.S. Das, learned counsel for the Petitioner prays for an adjournment after vacation.
3. Perusal of the order sheet reveals that on 12.03.2026 after arguing for some time, Mr. Das, learned counsel for the Petitioner had prayed for adjournment to make further submission for which the case was adjourned to 24.03.2026. On 24.03.2026, prayer for



adjournment was again made on behalf of Mr. B.S. Das, learned counsel for the Petitioner for which the case was adjourned to today.

4. Mr. Sangram Das, learned Standing Counsel for Vigilance Department submits that the case was posted to 25.08.2025 when the Petitioner was to appear in person for the purpose of framing of charge but the matter was adjourned on an application filed on behalf of the Petitioner to 12.09.2025. Thereafter on prayer of adjournment by the Petitioner, the matter has been adjourned a number of times. Now it is posted to 20.04.2026 for framing of charge.

5. List this matter on 24.06.2026.

6. It is made clear that pendency of this application will not be a ground for adjournment of the case by the learned trial Court.
