Petition prayer though is vague, the vagueness can be overcome by seeing the contents of Annexure-8.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that his client happens to be a differently abled person and that he has put up construction on the alleged encroached area, which he says that it has been allotted to him under a particular scheme. He also tells the Court that OPLE Case No.181 of 2002 is still pending and therefore, if a direction is given to hear and dispose off the same, that would meet out justice to his client.

3. Learned AGA appearing for the opposite parties is agreeable with the proposal of the petitioner.

In the above circumstances, the jurisdictional authority shall accomplish the proceedings in the subject OPLE Case No.181 of 2002 within an outer limit of six months. All contentions of the parties are kept open.



It is open to the petitioner to take up defenses that are available to him on account of his physical disability by vouching the same.

Till a final decision is taken, the petitioner shall not be disturbed from the occupation of the house in question.
