CMAPL No.285 of 2024

The Co-ordinate Bench vide order dated 26.04.2023 had dismissed this writ petition (W.P.(C) No.6616 of 2016) on the ground of non-prosecution. Now, an application is filed in CMAPL No.285 of 2024 supported by affidavit seeking recall of that order on the ground that counsel on record for the Petitioner was dead and gone. Death occurs in every house and that is recognized as a ground for recalling orders of the kind.

In the above circumstances, the CMAPL having been favoured the order dated 03.05.02025 stands recalled, as a consequence W.P.(C) No.6616 of 2016 restored to the Board.

This is subject to the Petitioner presenting a Book, namely, 'Writ Jurisdiction under the Constitution' by Justice B.L. Hansaria to the Madhusudan Library of Orissa High Court Bar Association within a period of three weeks, failing which writ petition runs the risk of dismissal.

Call this matter after four weeks.
