This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

Learned Counsel for the Petitioners appears through virtual mode and submits, as per the instructions received; the Opposite Party is residing at the address furnished in the cause title of the revision petition. The said address is also available in the impugned judgment passed in Criminal Proceeding No.32 of 2025. She further submits that the Opposite Party is intentionally avoiding to receive notice and vide order dated 29.08.2026, this Court has already held that notice on the Opposite Party to be sufficient. However, Petitioner No.1 is directed to file requisites for issuance of notice afresh through Court process by day after tomorrow (25.09.2026).

3. On filing of requisites, Office shall forward the same to the Office of learned District Judge, Berhampur at



Ganjam, who shall do well to communicate the same to the present Opposite Party and report compliance before the next date of listing.

4. That apart, a copy of this order be communicated to the IIC, Berhampur, Town PS, Ganjam, who shall do well to communicate the same to the present Opposite party and report compliance before the next date of listing.

5. It is made clear that if the Opposite Party remains unrepresented on the adjourned date, the revision petition, which has been preferred by the Petitioner and her minor daughter, shall be taken up for hearing and disposal in the absence of the Opposite Party-husband.

6. The matter be listed in the week commencing from 9th November, 2026.
