1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. Heard.
 3. Issue notice to the Opposite Party No.2-Victim by registered post with A.D. by fixing a short returnable date. Requisites shall be filed within three working days hence.
 4. Extra copy of the bail application be served on the learned Additional Government Advocate appearing for the State-Opposite Party No.1 within three working days hence, who in turn, shall transmit the same to the IIC/I.O. of the concerned Police Station to enable him to serve the same to the Victim/Opposite Party No.2 in this case and also intimate her that this case shall be taken up on 13th October, 2025 with regard



to grant of bail to the Petitioner by this Court. If the Opposite Party No.2/Victim has any objection, she shall appear in person in Court or through virtual mode on the said date. If the Opposite Party No.2/Victim agrees to appear through virtual mode, the I.I.C. of the concerned P.S. shall make necessary arrangement for the appearance of the Opposite Party No.2/Victim on the said date.

5. List this matter on 13th October, 2025.

6. Learned Additional Government Advocate appearing for the State-Opposite Party No.1 is directed to obtain the Case Diary including the statement of the victim recorded under Section 164 of Cr.P.C, if any, along with the report with regard to service of copy of such notice on the Victim/Opposite Party No.2 through the IIC/I.O. concerned on the next date.
