2. This is an application under Section 439(2) of Cr.P.C. for cancellation of bail granted to the Opposite Party No.2 by the learned J.M.F.C., Ranapur in G.R. Case No.236 of 2025 arising out of Ranapur P.S. Case No.158 of 2025 in pursuance of the order dated 07.08.2025 passed in ABLAPL No.6843 of 2025.
