



Chilika arising out of Nachuni P.S. Case No.232 of 2025 on the grounds stated.

4. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-1. It is alleged therein that the husband accused and other-in-laws ill-treated the informant and committed other mischief. The statement of the informant recorded during investigation under Section 180 BNSS is produced by learned counsel for the State. It is submitted that the informant is at present staying with her parents and nearly after two months from the last incident, the report was lodged. The further submission is that the allegation is against all. Learned counsel for the State however submits that the allegation against the accused father-in-law is serious and she attempted to outrage modesty of the informant as revealed during investigation. Considering the above facts and submissions of learned counsels for the respective parties, this Court is not inclined to grant pre-arrest bail to any of them but is of the view that the petitioners should be directed to surrender before the learned court below for orders.

5. Accordingly, it is ordered.

6. In the result, the ABLAPLs are disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. In the event, the petitioners surrender before the court of learned J.M.F.C, Chilika within a fortnight from today in connection with G.R Case No.515 of 2025 arising out of Nachuni P.S. Case No.232 of 2025, petitioner Nos.2 and 3 in ABLAPL No.11091 of 2025 shall be released



on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.30,000/-(rupees thirty thousand) each with one solvent surety for the like amount each with such other conditions imposed as deemed just and proper and in the facts and circumstances of the case. It is also directed that petitioner No.1, namely, Sahadeba Rana and the co-accused in ABLAPL No.12683 of 2025 upon their surrender within the above stipulated period shall move applications for bail to be considered by learned J.M.F.C, Chilika during the first hour and in case of rejection, are granted the liberty to approach the Sessions Court for orders during the second hour with all such plea taken by them for a decision on merit.
