1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
 2. This is an application for condonation of delay in filing of the present appeal.
 3. On perusal of the record it is revealed that as per the office note dated 23.09.2024 the appeal has been received from the jail with a delay of 171 days. Learned counsel for the Appellant at the outset contended that the appellant is a very poor person and he is in languishing in jail custody, as such he is unable to engage any counsel. Therefore, the present Jail Criminal Appeal has been filed with the help of the Legal Head Authorities.
 4. Learned counsel for the State on the other hand objected to the



said appeal on the ground that the delay has not been properly explained.

5. Taking into consideration the Submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for the parties, further keeping in view the fact that the appeal has been registered on the basis of a prisoner's petition, the delay of 171 days in filing the appeal is hereby condoned.
