1. Heard Mr. Khuntia, learned counsel for the petitioner.

2. Instant revision is filed by the petitioner challenging the impugned order dated 13th May, 2025 at Annexure-4 of learned S.D.J.M., Panposh, Rourkela in G.R. Case No.241 of 2012, whereby, an application Section 239 Cr.P.C. at Annexure-3 moved by her seeking discharge has been rejected.

3. It is submitted to the Court that the petitioner has been implicated as an abettor since working as a Sales Manager in the company in question at the relevant point of time. The further submission is that three other accused persons are primarily responsible to run the company and therefore, the petitioner should not have been chargesheeted and hence, such an application Section 239 Cr.P.C. was pressed into service but it has resulted in passing of the order as at Annexure-4.

4. To consider and appreciate the contention of Mr. Khuntia, learned counsel for the petitioner with the submission



that the case is of the year 2012 and the trial has not yet commenced and the limited role and responsibility of the petitioner of the company, the Court is inclined to peruse the statements of the witnesses and all other relevant documents collected during investigation and filed along with the chargesheet for final orders and hence, requests Mr. Sahoo, learned ASC to submit the same on the next date of hearing.
