01. 1. Heard Mr. Das, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Ray, learned AGA for the State.
2. Instant I.A. is filed for condonation of delay in presenting the revision beyond time.
3. Mr. Das, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the delay has occasioned as the petitioner had no knowledge about the order of cognizance in G.R. Case No. 224 of 2023 and thereafter, he approached this Court in CRLMC No.71 of 2023 but it was disposed of as being withdrawn with the liberty granted for him to file the revision, hence, the delay, which is required to be condoned in the interest of justice.
4. Objection Mr. Ray, learned counsel AGA for the State is recorded.



5. Gone through the facts pleaded on record and reason behind the delay. Considering the submission of Mr. Das, learned counsel for the petitioner and accepting the explanation offered towards such delay, the Court is inclined to condone the same in the interest of justice.

6. Accordingly, it is ordered.

7. I.A. stands allowed with the delay being condoned.
