06. 1. Issue notice as above. Accept one set of process fee.
2. This interim application has been filed with a prayer to restrain the Opposite Parties, more particularly, Opposite Party Nos.1 to 3 from taking any coercive action against the Petitioner in respect of the land in question.
2. Since finding a *prima facie* case, notice has been issued to the Opposite Parties, it is directed that *status quo* with regard to possession in respect of Plot No.3405 of Khata No.2239 to an extent Ac.1.000 dec. out of Ac.0.0364 dec. in Mouza-Patharagadia corresponding to Sabik Khata No.325/52 of Plot No.3403 shall be maintained till the next date.
3. It is further directed that no third party interest shall be created in respect of the aforesaid land by the parties to the writ petition in the meantime.
4. Issue urgent certified copy of this order on proper application.
