01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as learned counsel for the Informant and learned counsel for the State. Perused the application as well as the prayer made therein.
3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as the informant at the outset contended that the matter has been amicably resolved between the victim and the Petitioner and they have married in the meantime. It was submitted that they are presenting staying together and leading a happy conjugal life. In the meantime, they have also been blessed with child.
4. In view of the aforesaid development, learned counsels appearing for the Petitioner and the informant sought for some time to file a joint affidavit by both parties.



5. Let the affidavit be filed within ten days after serving a copy thereof on learned counsel for the State, who shall obtain instruction regarding the same. Learned counsel for the State shall also obtain the case diary and statement of the victim recorded under Section 164 of Cr.P.C., if any.

6. List this matter in the week commencing 17th November, 2025.
