Issue emergent notice. Learned AGA, on request, accepts notice for opposite party no.1. A copy of the writ petition with all documents be served on him within three working days. Learned Senior Counsel appears on behalf of opposite party nos.2 to 4.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner draws attention of the Court to I.A. No.17518 of 2025 supported by affidavit, where he apprehends that pursuant to impugned order the supply of electricity may be disrupted to the building under construction and therefore, the same has to be halted. He assures the Court that the *status quo* would be maintained without putting one single brick in the construction till next date of hearing. This is absolutely fair.



In the above circumstances, it is directed that opposite party nos.2 & 3 shall not take any coercive step for disrupting the power supply to the building in question.
