1. An application supported by an affidavit seeks condonation of a short delay of 53 days. A plausible explanation is offered for condonation of delay inasmuch as during the relevant period the law relating to computation of period of limitation was not settled which eventually came to be settled by the Full Bench decision of this Court. Even otherwise condonation of delay would not add merits to the case of appellant to the disadvantage of the other side.
