**ORDER
05.11.2024**

01. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

The petitioner, Debendra Sahoo has filed this writ petition with a prayer to quash Annexure-3 and a direction to the opp. party no.2, Judge -in- charge Accounts, Jagatsinghpur to pay the full salary i.e. Rs.21,360/- per month by not deducting Rs.7,464/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner by drawing the attention of the Court to the appointment letter issued by the District Judge, Jagatsinghpur argues that the petitioner was supposed to receive pay and allowances at



the rate he was drawing at that time of retirement minus total amount of pension being received by him after commutation under the Pension Rules applicable to him.

It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that at the time of retirement, the petitioner was drawing the salary of Rs.31,968/- and his pension amount is Rs.10,608/- and therefore, the petitioner is entitled to Rs.21,360/- but the authorities have deducted overdrawal amount of Rs.7,464/- and he is getting only Rs.2,536/-.

Issue notice to the opp. parties on the question of admission indicating therein that the matter shall be disposed of at the stage of admission.

Mr. Nayak, learned Addl. Govt. Advocate accepts notice on behalf of all the opp. parties and submits that he has received a copy of the writ petition and seeks some time to obtain instruction.

Put up this matter in the week commencing from 09.12.2024.

Counter, if any, to the writ petition be filed in the meantime.
