04. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since paragraph-4 of the order passed by this Court on 11.04.2023 in WA No.131 of 2023 has not yet been complied with, the petitioner has filed the present CONTC.
3. Paragraph-4 of the aforesaid order is extracted as under:-
- “Following the judgment in **Narottam Rath v. State of Odisha (supra)**, this Court sets aside the impugned order and directs that the Appellant’s name will be entered in the ROR as prayed for while at the same time reserving the liberty of the Government to proceed in accordance with law under Section 3B of the OGLS Act.”*
4. In view of the aforesaid direction, the petitioner is directed to approach the office of Tahasildar, Bhubaneswar along with copy of this order and in such event, the Tahasildar, Bhubaneswar shall do well to comply the order passed by this



Court, especially in paragraph-4 of the order dated 11.04.2023 passed in WA No.131 of 2023.
