1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. This application has been filed for grant of bail to the Appellant Nos.2 & 3, namely, Purna Chandra Brahma and Premalata Brahma.
3. Learned counsel for the Appellants submits that the Appellant Nos.2 & 3 are the father-in-law and mother-in-law of the deceased. The Appellant Nos.2 & 3 are in custody since 26.09.2025. The Appellants were on bail during the trial and they have never mis-utilized the liberty. He, therefore, prays for grant of bail to the Appellants for a certain period on any such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper.
4. Learned counsel for the State opposes the move.
5. Taking into account the submissions made and on going through the impugned judgment and viewing the



surrounding circumstances; it is directed that further execution of sentence imposed upon the Appellant Nos.2 & 3 in Sessions Trial Case No.310 of 2022, by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Presiding Officer, Designated Court, Under O.P.I.D. Act, Cuttack shall remain suspended and the Appellant Nos.2 & 3 be released on bail pending disposal of this Appeal.

6. Accordingly, it is directed that the Appellant Nos.2 & 3, namely, Purna Chandra Brahma and Premalata Brahma be released on bail pending disposal of this Appeal on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper by the Trial Court with further condition that they shall positively surrender before the Trial Court as and when so required.

7. The I.A. is accordingly disposed of.
