02. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner Dhuleswar Das with the following reliefs;

- i. To quash the order dated 02.04.2024 under Annexure-6.
- ii. To direct the opposite parties no.1 to 5 to regularize the service of the applicant within a stipulated period with all service and financial benefits.

In pursuance of the order dated 19.11.2024, learned counsel for the petitioner files the copies of the orders passed by this Court in different writ petitions in
