This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Mr. Dalai, learned Counsel for the Opposite Party No.4 submits, pursuant to order dated 27.10.2022, the Petitioner filed CONTC No.3003 of 2023 for flouting of the said order by his client and being directed in the said Contempt proceeding, the Petitioner was permitted to join her duty in terms of the order dated 27.10.2022 passed in I.A. No.14506 of 2022.

3. Mr. Dalai, hands up the photocopy of the Resolution No.158 of Bania GPLF Ganjam and submits, as is revealed from proposal No. 3, though the Petitioner was permitted to rejoin her duty with effect from 12.02.2024 in terms of order passed by this Court, but she is not attending her duty and as per the information received, at present she is working in Sri Aurovinda Purnanga Sikhyakendra at Khallikote.

4. Per contra, learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits, despite the order passed by the Co-ordinate Bench in the



present Writ Petition, followed by order passed in CONTC No.2148 of 2023 and CONTC NO.3003 of 2023, though the Petitioner was allowed to join her duty, neither she is permitted to work as MBK nor she has been paid her salary.

5. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner prays for a week's time to take instruction and file an Affidavit dealing with the allegations made by the Opposite Party No.4 G.P.L.F.

6. Learned Counsel for the Opposite Party No.4 is also permitted to file Affidavit with further information, if any, with regard to alleged employment of the Petitioner and not reporting for duty since 12.02.2024.

7. Learned State Counsel is also directed to ascertain as to the correctness of the allegations made by the Opposite Party No.4 through the B.D.O., Khallikote Opposite Party No.3 and file an affidavit before the next date of listing.

8. The matter be listed under the heading "For Admission" in the week commencing from 19th August, 2024.

9. Learned Counsel for the parties are directed to file their respective Affidavits before the next date of listing after exchanging copies between them.
