- 01.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
2. The Petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with C.T. Case No.1441 of 2025 pending on the file of learned J.M.F.C.-V, Bhubaneswar arising out of Bharatpur P.S. Case No.465 of 2025 for commission of offences punishable under Sections 324(2)/318(4) of BNS.
3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner undertakes to implead the informant as Opposite Party No.2. Consolidated cause title along with requisites for issuance of notice by Speed Post to the newly added Opposite Party shall be filed by 23.10.2025.

Informant be noticed through the I.O.. Extra copy of the brief for the purpose be served on the learned counsel for the State by 23.10.2025 as well.



4. List this matter on 10.12.2025. Learned counsel for the State is called upon to obtain the Case Diary in the meanwhile.

5. As an interim measure, it is directed that the Petitioner shall not be taken into custody in connection with the aforesaid case, till the next date.

In the event steps for issuance of notice are not taken, as directed, the interim order shall stand vacated.

6. It is needless to say that the Petitioner shall cooperate with the Investigating Agency.

7. Copy of this order be made over to the learned counsel for the State to do the needful.
