1. Since Mr. Kanungo, learned Senior Advocate appearing for the petitioner is not available at present, as informed to the Court, list the matter tomorrow i.e. on 12th November, 2025 for final hearing under the heading of 'Specially Adjourned Matters'.

2. Mr. Nanda, learned counsel appearing for opposite party Nos. 4 to 22 submits that despite an order of this Court on 6th November, 2025, the counting of votes has not been held. The further submission is that there has been no such prohibition against counting in the order in I.A. No. 17936 of 2025 which is to the effect that the motion shall be held but the result thereof not to be furnished without the leave of the Court.



3. In view of the submission as above, Mr. Sahoo, learned ASC for the State is directed to immediately intimate opposite party No.3 to comply the Court's order dated 6th November, 2025 and to ensure that the counting of the votes is concluded and to report back.
