1. Heard.

2. The operative portion of the judgment for alleged non-compliance of which the present CONTC is filed runs thus;

“Hence, the Opposite Parties are hereby directed to appoint the Petitioner as Constable (General Duty) in Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) and SSF, Rifleman (GD) in Assam Rifles and Sepoy in Narcotics Control Bureau Examination, 2022 within a period of three month from the date of receipt/submission of the copy of the judgment.”

3. It is stated at the Bar that no intra court appeal has been preferred.

4. Since this matter was listed on 28.01.2026 adjournment was sought for by the learned CGC appearing for the Opposite Party No.2 to respond to the averments made. Thereafter, taking note that an I.A. has been filed the matter was adjourned to this day.

5. In I.A. No.73 of 2026 prayer has been made for grant of three months time and the prayer in the I.A. reads as under;

“It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to grant extension of (03) months’ time to the Opposite Party No.2 for necessary action at its end;

And pass such other order/orders, direction/directions as may be deemed fit and proper.

6. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that on a bare perusal of the I.A. it can be

seen that the authorities are somehow trying to buy time instead of implementing the orders passed by this Court.

7. On going through the recitals of the I.A., this Court is persuaded that there is substance in the submissions made. Accordingly, issue notice of the CONTC application to the Opposite Party No.2 by Speed Post.

Issue notice to the Opposite Party No.1 as well. Requisites for issuance of notices shall be filed by 09.02.2026.

8. List this matter on 10.03.2026.
