1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. This is the bail application U/S.483 of the BNSS by the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with Ramamchandrapur PS Case No. 129 of 2025 corresponding to CT Case No.738 of 2055 pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge(Jr. Division)-cum-JMFC, Baripal, Jajpur for commission of offences punishable U/Ss.467/420 of IPC, on the main allegation of cheating the informant for a sum of Rs. 4 Lakhs by not refunding the money after taking it as an investment.
3. Heard, Mrs. Anita Rani Panda, learned counsel for the petitioner; Mr. Sudipto Panda, learned counsel for the informant and Mr. S.C. Pradhan, learned Additional Public Prosecutor in the matter and perused the record.
4. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of the offences as alleged against the petitioner vis-à-vis the



accusations sought to be brought against him and regard being had to the pre trial detention of the petitioner in custody since 18.07.2025 with submission of charge sheet in the meantime and taking into account the other circumstances on record in entirety including the law laid down by the Apex Court in ***Satender Kumar Antil Vrs. Central Bureau of Investigation; (2022) 10 SCC 51***, this Court without expressing any view on merit admits the petitioner to bail.

5. Hence, the bail application of the petitioner stands allowed and the petitioner is allowed to go on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin of the case on such terms and conditions as deem fit and proper by it.

6. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of. Issue urgent certified copy of the order as per Rules.
