1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant I.A. is filed under Section 5 of the Limitation Act seeking condonation of delay.
3. A delay of 3676 days as pointed out by the SR.
4. Ignorance of the impugned order of cognizance i.e. Annexure-7 is the plea of the petitioner while demanding the delay to be condoned.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has approached this Court in CRLMC Nos.39 and 1503 of 2025 and only upon the liberty granted, the revision petition is filed and hence, the delay, which has occasioned, should be condoned in the interest of justice.
6. A serious objection is received from Ms. Dash, learned ASC for the State and at the same time, a request is received



from her to reply upon verifying the record and to ascertain whether the petitioner had the knowledge with regard to the action being taken by the Drug Inspector, Ganjam-1 Range. In view of the above request received, for a reply to the I.A., hearing of the matter is adjourned.
