1. When the matter was argued on 24.10.2025 by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the following order was passed:

“1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner has accommodation to apprise the Court as to whether the petitioner had ever applied for appointment under Odisha Civil Services (Rehabilitation Assistant) Rules as amended till date. He shall also apprise this Court whether the petitioner got engagement as a daily wager under the R.A. Rules or otherwise.

2. As prayed for, list on 10th November, 2025.”

2. Today we have brought to the notice of the learned counsel for the petitioner the said order. In response, it is submitted that apart from stating in paragraph-6 of the writ petition regarding the



petitioner requesting the authorities for appointment under Rehabilitation Assistance, there is no other documents to substantiate the claim of the petitioner that he had applied for appointment under the Rehabilitation Assistance Scheme after death of his father who was working as Process Server in the establishment of Registrar, Civil Courts, Kendrapara. It is further submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that Annexure-5 i.e. representation made to the Registrar, Civil Courts, Kendrapara for compassionate appointment.

3. At this stage we are issuing notice on the question of admission. The opposite party shall file their response by the next date.
