- 02.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsels for the State as well as informant.
2. The Petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Special G.R. Case No.104 of 2025 pending on the file of learned Additional Session Judge-Cum-Special Judge, POCSO, Jagatsinghpur, arising out of Kujanga P.S. Case No.326 of 2025 for commission of offences punishable under Sections 137(2) and 87 of BNS 2023 read with Section 12 of POCSO Act.
- 3 It is submitted by the learned counsel that omnibus allegations have been made and ex facie the



allegations under the POCSO Act are not made out, the Petitioner may be protected by pre-arrest bail.

4. Learned counsel for the State as well as informant opposes the prayer for pre-arrest bail.

5. This Court perused the statement of the victim recorded under Section 183 of BNSS.

6. Considering the tenor thereof, this Court directs that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the Petitioner shall be released on bail by the learned Court in seisin on such terms as deemed just and proper.

7. It is needless to state that the Petitioner shall cooperate with the ongoing investigation.

8. Accordingly, the ABLAPL stands disposed of.
