Heard Ms. S. Devi learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner, who happens to be the widow of the deceased loanee and the proprietrix of 1st Petitioner entity. She mentions about the ordeals, she underwent because of death of her husband and also the person genus issues. She seeks referring of the matter for mediation under Section 89 of the CPC 1908.

2. Learned Sr. Adv. Mr. Dash, representing the OSFC having opposed the petition, now very fairly agrees for the proposal for mediation. We have seen elements of mediability and therefore, ours is the opinion that mediation is worth undertaking.



In the above circumstances, matters stand referred to High Court Mediation Centre. Parties shall appear before the Coordinator of the Centre on 09.03.2026 at 3:00 P.M. and take further instruction at his hands. The Coordinator is requested to cause accomplishment of mediation at the trained hands within an outer limit of eight (8) weeks reckoned from this day.

All coercive proceedings for recovery would stand at bay, till next date of hearing.
