02. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
2. The Petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.985 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C, Banarpal, arising out Banarpal P.S. Case No.487 of 2025 for commission of offences punishable under Sections 318(2)/69/296/351(3) of BNS.
3. Perused the statement of the victim recorded under Section 183 of BNSS.
4. Considering the tenor thereof, this Court is not inclined to entertain the prayer for pre-arrest bail. However, ABLAPL is disposed of with the observation that the Petitioner may surrender before the learned



J.M.F.C, Banarpal in connection with the
aforementioned case within one month from today.

4. In the event of his surrender and motion for
bail, the application for bail shall be considered by the
learned J.M.F.C, Banarpal on merits in accordance with
law in the first hour of the day. In the event of rejection
of the prayer for bail by the learned J.M.F.C, Banarpal,
the Petitioner is at liberty to move the higher forum for
bail in the second hour on the same day.

5. On being so moved, the higher forum is
requested to make an endeavour to dispose of the bail
application of the Petitioner on the same day on merit
in accordance with law.

The case diary shall be made available to the
concerned courts to facilitate disposal of the bail
application of the Petitioner and learned J.M.F.C,
Banarpal is called upon to transmit the case record to
the higher forum in the second hour expeditiously in
the event of rejection of such bail application.

6. Accordingly, the ABLAPL stands disposed of.
