- 2.**      The present Writ Petition has been filed inter alia with the following prayer:

*Under the above circumstances, it is humbly prayed that the writ petition may be allowed;*

*And*



*(A) a writ of mandamus or an appropriate writ may be issued commanding the opposite parties to select and appoint the petitioner as Food Safety Officer against PwD Category by revising the select list published by virtue of notification dated 07.05.2022 issued by the Odisha Staff Selection Commission, Bhubaneswar under Annexure-7 series;*

*And pass such other order/orders and to issue such other writ/writs as would afford complete relief to the Petitioner.*

*And for this act of kindness, the Petitioner as in duty bound shall remain ever pray.*

**3.** However, taking into account the claim raised in the present Writ Petition, liberty is granted to the Petitioner to make a fresh representation before Opp. Party No.1 by enclosing all the relevant documents and citations in support of his claim, if any, within a period of three (3) weeks hence.

**4.** It is observed that if any such representation is filed within the aforesaid time period, Opp. Party No. 1 shall do well to take a lawful decision on the same within a period of three (3) months from the date of receipt of such representation. The order so passed by Opp. Party No. 1 be communicated to the Petitioner.

**5.** With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
