1. Heard Mr. Patro, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Ray, learned AGA for the State.

2. Instant IA is filed seeking condonation of delay for having presented the revision beyond the stipulated period.

3. A delay of 928 days is reported as per the SR.

4. Mr. Patro, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner filed CRLMC No.1143 of 2025, however, the same was disposed of with the liberty granted to file a revision against the impugned order i.e. Annexure-1 to the revision petition, hence, the delay, which is, hence, required to be condoned in the interest of justice.

5. Recorded the objection of Mr. Ray, learned AGA for the State.

Considering the explanation offered and since the petitioner filed CRLMC before this Court and liberty has been granted to him in presenting the revision and accordingly, it has been complied with, recording the objection of State, the Court is of the view that the delay which has occurred should be condoned in the interest of justice in order to facilitate disposal of the revision on merit.
