2. This Interlocutory Application has been filed by the Petitioner with a prayer to implead the Informant as Opposite Party No.2 in this case.
3. Mr. Jagannath Patnaik, learned Senior Counsel; along with Ms. Soma Patnaik, learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner.
4. On perusal of the application, it appears that by filing the present CRLMC application under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., the



Petitioner seeks quashing of the entire criminal proceeding. Therefore, the Informant is a necessary party to the present CRLMC application.

5. In the aforesaid finding, the I.A. for impleading the Informant as Opposite Party No.2 is allowed.

6. Corrected copy of the cause-title of the CRLMC application be filed by day after tomorrow.
