1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).

 4. In such view of the matter, the parties are granted four weeks' time to make an effort to resolve the dispute peacefully and amicably.

7. As an interim measure, it is directed that on an application being filed by the Petitioner before the court in seisin over the matter seeking adjournment of the case, the court in seisin over the matter shall do well to adjourn the case for a period of four weeks.
