1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

2. The Petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with C.T. Case No.206 of 2024 pending in the Court of learned Nyayadhikari Gram Nyayalaya, Attabira, Bargarh, arising out of Attabira P.S. No.215 of 2024, for commission of offence punishable under Sections 120(B)/420/468/471/409 of IPC.

3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner undertakes to implead the Informant as Opposite Party No.2. Consolidated cause title along with requisites for issuance of notice by Speed Post to the newly added Opposite Party, shall be filed by 11.11.2025.

Informant be noticed through the I.O.. Extra copy of the brief for the purpose be served on the learned counsel for the State by 11.11.2025 as well.



4. List this matter on 10.12.2025. Learned counsel for the State is requested to obtain the Case Diary in the meanwhile.

5. As an interim measure, it is directed that no coercive action shall be taken against the Petitioner in connection with the aforesaid case till the next date.

In the event steps for issuance of notice are not taken, as directed, the interim order shall stand vacated.

6. It is needless to state that the Petitioner shall cooperate with the ongoing investigation.
