01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.
2. By means of this application, the Petitioner seeks the intervention of this Court for a direction to the Opposite Party Nos.2 and 3 to cause the arrest of the Opposite Party No.4 in connection with the Korei P.S. U.D. Case No.7 of 2025.
3. As seen from the case record and submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioner, pursuant to the complaint lodged, an unnatural death case has been registered on 17.05.2025 vide SL. No.7 of 2025 concerning Korai P.S. U.D. Case No.7 of 17.05.2025. In course of the aforesaid enquiry in the U.D. Case, the E.O. examined the Informant and visited the spot, examined the local villagers and other witnesses, recorded their statements, verified the spot,



conducted the inquest over the dead body of the deceased Basanta Nath in presence of the Informant and other family members as well as other witnesses at the spot, the dead body was sent to CHC, Dangadi, Jajpur for P.M. examination, other local villagers have also been examined so also the friends of the deceased, recorded their statement, the P.M. report in respect of the deceased from CHC, Dangadi was received wherein the doctor opined that the internal findings are ante mortem in nature and internal findings of lungs along with trachea one consisted and the death is due to asphyxia as a result of ante mortem drowning. However, the viscera was preserved and sent for further examination to the SFSL, Rasulgarh, the preliminary report of the SFSL, Rasulgarh reveals that ethyl alcohol was detected on the viscera of the deceased. However, the enquiry is still in progress awaiting the diatom C.E. report to rule out the cause of death to be one of drowning.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid instructions submitted from the side of the IIC, Korai P.S., the learned counsel for the State is directed to take further instruction in the matter. List this case on 05.12.2025 for appriasal.
