1. This is an application for stay operation of the impugned order dated 31.07.2025 passed by the learned Judge, Family Court, Jagatsinghpur in C.R.P. No.80 of 2024 pending disposal of the Criminal Revision.
2. Issue notice as above.
3. Accept one set of process fee.



4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that directing the Petitioner-husband to pay interim maintenance of Rs.4000/- per month to the Opposite Party-wife is harsh keeping in view his societal responsibility and that the Opposite Party-wife is also earning sufficiently to maintain herself.

5. Taking into account that the arrear maintenance of 16 months is due, it is directed that on Petitioner depositing a sum of Rs.30,000/- (rupees thirty thousand) towards arrear maintenance and continuing to pay Rs.2000/- (rupees two thousand) per month as current interim maintenance falling due from 9.2.2026, further proceeding in C.R.P. No.80 of 2024 on the file of learned Judge, Family Court, Jagatsinghpur shall remain stayed till the next date.

6. On such deposit it shall be open for the Opposite Party-wife to seek release of the same in accordance with law. In the event arrear maintenance of Rs.30,000/- along with current maintenance of Rs.2000/- as directed is not deposited on or before 9.2.2026, the interim order shall stand vacated without further reference to the Bench.
