1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. This is an application has been filed for revival of the CONTC No.6699 of 2022 which was disposed of by a Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 20.12.2024 by granting liberty to the Petitioner to take recourse to appropriate remedy after disposal of the matter pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as learned counsel for the Contemnor.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner contended that the matter which was pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court has already been disposed of. Therefore, the Petitioner has again approached



this Court with a prayer to revive the contempt application.
