1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners as well as learned counsel for the State. Perused the application as well as the prayer made therein.
3. Learned counsel for the Petitioners at the outset contended that the dispute involved in the present application arises out of a matrimonial discord between the Petitioner No.1-husband and Opposite Party No.2-wife. He further submitted that in the meantime the decree of divorce has been granted on mutual consent under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act. He further submitted that the parties have amicably settled the dispute and that the Opposite Party No.2 does not want to proceed further in the present criminal case.



4. Considering the aforesaid submission, this Court is inclined to issue notice to the Opposite Parties.

5. Since Mr. Singh, learned Additional Standing Counsel for State-Opposite Party accepts notice on behalf of Opposite Party No.1, let an extra copy of the brief be served on him within three working days.

6. Issue notice to the Opposite Party No.2 by Speed Post with A.D. by fixing a short returnable date. Requisites be filed within three working days.

7. List this matter in the week commencing 01.12.2025.

9. Notice as above.

10. Accept one set of process fee.

11. As an interim measure, it is directed that on an application being filed by the Petitioners seeking adjournment before the learned trial court, learned trial court shall do well to adjourn G.R. Case No.492 of 2021 for a period of six weeks.
