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1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. On perusal of the stamp report it appears that there is a delay of 2547 days in preferring the appeal. Learned counsel for the Appellant submitted that although the appellant has entrusted the brief to one of his relative to arrange a lawyer to prefer an appeal, however, no steps were taken. Since then the appellant has been in custody and he could not take effective steps for filing of the appeal within the time and aforesaid delay was not within his knowledge. On verification it is found that the appeal has been filed with a delay of 2547 days.
 3. Learned counsel for the state on the other hand objected to the condonation of delay. He further contended that he wishes to file an objection to the I.A. seeking condonation of delay. Learned counsel for the State is granted two weeks' time to file his objection after serving a



copy thereof on the learned counsel for the appellant.
