01. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. This application has been filed by the Petitioner seeking interim bail on the ground that the wife of the Petitioner namely, Aarati Harijan is suffering from acute gynecological problems. There is no male member in the family to take care of her treatment. It is submitted that earlier the Petitioner was released on bail and surrendered to custody without misusing the liberty.



4. Learned State counsel though opposes the prayer for grant of interim bail yet, fairly submits that considering the grounds, the Court may pass appropriate order.

5. Having considered the submissions made and the ground on which the prayer for interim bail is made, I am inclined to allow the same. Let the Petitioner be released on interim bail for a period of two months from the date of his actual release on such terms and conditions as may be fixed by the court in seisin over the matter including the condition that he shall not misuse the liberty granted to him.

6. After expiry of the aforesaid period of two months, the Petitioner shall surrender before the court in seisin over the matter, failing which appropriate warrant may be issued for his production

7. The I.A. is disposed of.

8. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application.
